

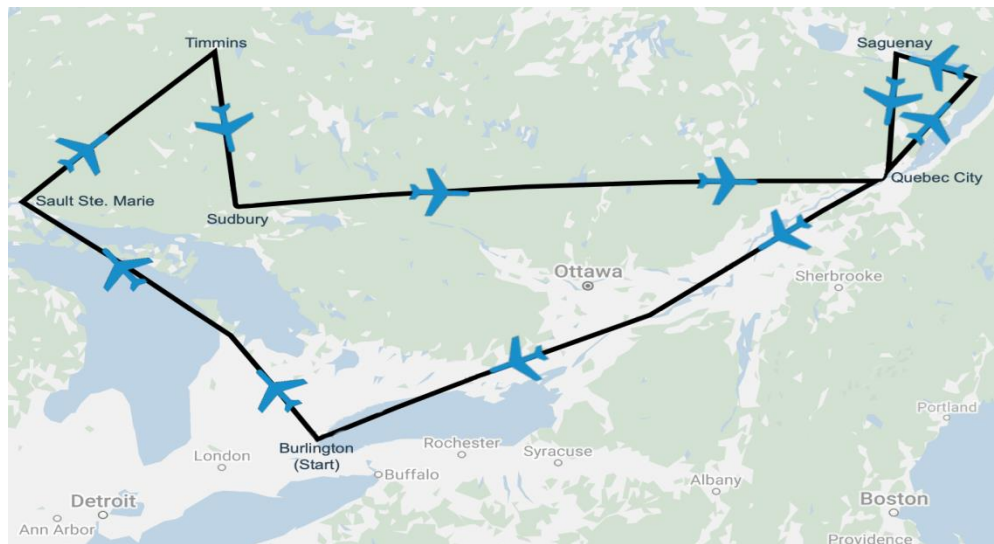


FLIGHT OPPORTUNITY

Another epic flight to launch hundreds of others

In autumn of 2020, Hope Air is engaging pilots and planes in the 3rd annual Give Hope Wings expedition that will bridge the gap between home and hospital for hundreds of patients. It's an ambitious multi-aircraft five-day expedition that will allow Hope Air to launch many flights to medical care. It departs from Burlington, flying over Niagara Falls, up the sandy coast of Lake Huron along the Bruce Peninsula, north to Sault Ste. Marie. Then the squadron will fly over the Agawa Canyon, catching rugged aerial views of the east shore of Lake Superior and stopping off in Timmins and Sudbury. Then over the picturesque Ottawa and St. Lawrence rivers to historic Quebec City, with a unique fly-out over the Saguenay River fjord and then back to Burlington. The expedition will create vital awareness and raise \$100,000 to fund 400 flights to medical care for low income patients who must travel far for the medical care they need. Please consider joining and supporting the expedition.

- Timeframe: 5 days, September 30 to October 4, 2020
- Goals: \$100,000 raised for patient travel, an experience of a lifetime for participating pilots

- Day 1 – Wednesday Sept. 30, 2020 (Burlington to Sault Ste. Marie) (370 nm)
 - 08:00 – 09:30 Community Landing in Burlington (CZBA)
 - 09:30 – 11:30 Fly-out over Niagara Falls with incredible aerial views
 - 11:30 – 1:00 Lunch at Warton Airport
 - 1:00 – 3:00 Fly up the beautiful Bruce Peninsula and Manitoulin Island to Sault Ste. Marie (CYAM)
 - 16:30 – 17:30 Visit to Bush Plane Museum
 - Stay overnight in Sault Ste. Marie
- Day 2 – Thursday Oct. 1, 2020 (Sault Ste. Marie to Sudbury) (350 nm)

 - 10:00 -12:00 Fly from Quebec City to Cornwall (CYCC)

 - 14:00 – 16:30 Fly from Cornwall to Burlington (CZBA)
